O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on November 12, 1954, discloses that the switching limits of Salinas Station, located 2.6 miles east of Graves Station, have been extended to include Graves Station providing a continued freight service which will be at least as satisfactory as at present, that no passenger business has been transacted at applicant's station of Graves for the past several years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its Class "A" non-agency station of Graves, County of Monterey; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization

shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
