FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 50786 of November 23, 1954, in this proceeding authorized applicant to transport flour within San Francisco for nine shippers at rates less than the established minimum rates. By supplemental application he seeks the same authority in connection with the transportation of the same commodity for Pillsbury Mills.

Applicant states that the operating conditions surrounding the transportation for Pillsbury Mills are the same as those applicable in connection with the other shippers. He declares that if the sought authority is not granted the transportation will be diverted to proprietary carriage.

In the circumstances it appears that the sought modification of the authority is justified and should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first ordering paragraph of Decision No. 50786 of November 23, 1954, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended by adding thereto Pillsbury Mills.

In all other respects said Decision No. 50786 shall remain in full force and effect.
