ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing by Decision No. 50576, dated September 21, 1954, in Application No. 35674, that Claire L. Pleas was authorized to establish and operate a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers within the City of Visalia and between Visalia and certain points in the immediate vicinity of Visalia;

It further appearing that no evidence of adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage is now on file with the Commission by said Claire L. Pleas, as required by General Order No. 101;

It further appearing that no effective tariff or timetable is now on file with the Commission by said Claire L. Pleas;

It further appearing by letter dated December 10, 1954 that said Claire L. Pleas, through her attorney, informed the Commission of her intention to discontinue the above-described operation; and

It further appearing after investigation by this Commission that said Claire L. Pleas is not conducting and has abandoned the above-described operation without the requisite authority;

Therefore, it is found that the operative right granted to Claire L. Pleas by Decision No. 50576 should be revoked.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right represented by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Claire L. Pleas by Decision No. 50576 in the above-entitled proceeding be and it hereby is revoked. .

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Claire L. Pleas in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Claire L. Pleas, unless said Claire L. Pleas before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
