OPINION AND ORDER

Southern California Gas Company and the City of Long Beach by the above-entitled application filed December 16, 1954, request an order of this Commission, under Section 851 of the Public Utilities Code, authorizing Southern California Gas Company to sell and the City of Long Beach to buy certain gas distribution facilities located in territory recently annexed to the City of Long Beach, California. A detail of the facilities to be purchased is set forth in an agreement dated November 5, 1954, attached to and made a part of the application as Exhibit "A".

Southern California Gas Company, hereinafter referred to as "Southern", is engaged in the purchase, distribution and sale of gas in the central and southern portions of the State of California, including certain areas in and contiguous to the City of Long Beach, California. City of Long Beach, hereinafter referred to as "City", operates a municipally owned gas system largely located within the limits of the incorporated City of Long Beach.

The distribution facilities, as of September 30, 1954, to be sold to the City and as covered by the agreement dated November 5, 1954, consist of 7,925 feet of gas mains and 324 feet of service pipe, together with valves, fittings and other appurtenances attached

of the property transfer herein authorized.

The action taken herein shall not be construed to be a finding of the value of the property herein authorized to be transferred.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
