ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHT

It appearing by Decision No. 50360, dated August 3, 1954, in Application No. 35610, that Melvin J. Duehring and Frank C. Svehla were authorized to establish and operate a passenger stage service for the transportation of passengers between the Masonite plant northeast of Ukiah, on the one hand, and Kelseyville and the intermediate points of Upper Lake and points along California State Highway 29, including Lakeport, on the other hand; and

It further appearing that said Melvin J. Duehring and Frank C. Svehla have not complied with any of the requirements of said Decision No. 50360, to wit: the certificate has not been accepted, service has not been established, tariffs and timetables have not been received, and no evidence of adequate insurance has been filed;

Therefore, it is found that the above-described operative right granted by said Decision No. 50360 should be revoked.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right, represented by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Melvin J. Duehring and Frank C. Svehla by Decision No. 50360 in the above-entitled proceeding, be and hereby is revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Melvin J. Duehring and Frank C. Svehla in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Melvin J. Duehring and Frank C. Svehla, unless said Melvin J. Duehring and Frank C. Svehla before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be stayed until hearing is held and further order issued.
