## OPINION

D. B. Stutsman, doing business as Shasta Terrace Water System, seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate a public water system in Shasta Terrace subdivision, Shasta County, and to have a schedule of rates established for such service.

A public hearing was held before Examiner Carl Silverhart at Redding on December 21, 1954, and the matter, which was unopposed, was submitted on such date.

The subdivision contains 148 lots, and is located approximately two miles south of Redding. It is contemplated that construction of 125 residential units therein will be commenced in the near future. A map attached to the application as Exhibit "C" sets forth the location of the well, tank and mains.

The water supply for this system will be obtained from a well located about 500 feet south of the area to be served. The well is situated on a parcel of land 112 feet square, title to which will be conveyed to applicant. It is proposed that a 25 h.p. electric motor directly connected to a deep well turbine pump will be installed in the well. The well is expected to deliver about 300 g.p.m. against a system pressure of 40 pounds per square inch which will be maintained by a 10,000-gallon pressure tank located on a portion

4. Applicant shall base the accruals to depreciation upon spreading the original cost of the plant, less estimated net salvage and depreciation reserve, over the estimated remaining life of the property. Applicant shall review the accruals when major changes in plant composition occur and for each plant account at intervals of not more than five years. Results of these reviews shall be submitted to this Commission.

The authorization herein granted will expire if not exercised within one year after the effective date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
