O P I N I O N

Applicant Transcontinental Bus System, Inc., presently rendering a passenger stage service between various points within the State requests authority to extend service from Woods Corner to Parks Air Force Base.

As justification for the authority sought, applicant alleges that one time the Base had its main gate on U. S. Highway 50 and was directly served by applicant's predecessor Santa Fe Transportation Company. Subsequently, the main gate was placed on Daugherty Road, a point approximately nine-tenths of a mile north of Woods Corner; that applicant presently serves the Base in inter-state commerce and has received numerous requests from personnel assigned to Parks Air Force Base for transportation to presently authorized points such as San Francisco, Oakland, Stockton and Los Angeles. Pacific Greyhound Lines, which also serves the Base, has informed the Commission by letter that it will not protest the application.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that Route 2 between Stockton and Manteca, as described in Decision No. 49871 dated March 30, 1954 on Application No. 34650, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

- (c) Beginning at Woods Corner located on U. S. Highway 50, thence via Daugherty Road to the Main Gate of Parks Air Force Base and return over the same route.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
