ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a publicly-used road at Milepost 246.6 near Anderson, Shasta County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. C-246.6. Construction of said crossing as well as the existing main line crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 without superelevation and the width of both crossings shall be not less than 24 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six percent. Protection shall be by an additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

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Applicant alleges that the industry desiring this proposed spur track will utilize it in the construction of the industry's new plant, now being built, and requests that authority be made effective immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
