## OPINION

Metropolitan Coach Lines is a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the California Public Utilities Code. As such it has authority from this Commission for the transportation of persons via the Following route in the City of Los Angeles:

## Fairfax Avenue Line No. 89

From Fairfax Avenue and 18th Street, thence along 18th Street, Genesee Avenue, Venice Boulevard, Fairfax Avenue, Sunset Boulevard, La Brea Avenue, Hollywood Boulevard, Gower Street, Franklin Avenue, and Western Avenue to Santa Monica Boulevard. Return via reverse of above route.

Also, from Frænklin Avenue and Beachwood Drive, thence along Beachwood Drive to Westshire Drive. Return via reverse of above route. (1)

By the application herein, filed on January 12, 1955, Metropolitan Coach Lines seeks authority to route the above described service between the intersection of Hollywood Boulevard and Argyle Avenue and the intersection of Gower Street and
