ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 41264, dated March 2, 1948, in the above application, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and Southern Pacific Company were granted authority to operate freight cars of a height of 16 feet 4-3/4 inches from top of rail to top of running board from the state line near Needles, California, over a specified route to Mulford, California, and the empty cars to be returned over the same route. The first supplemental order therein, Decision No. 48262, dated February 10, 1953, authorized the movement of such excess height freight cars under load over a portion of the same route from Mulford to Barstow, California.

Under these authorizations automobile bodies were transported in the excess height freight cars to and from the Chrysler Corporation's Mulford, California assembly plant. The Commission has been advised that Chrysler Corporation has discontinued operations at this plant and that the movement of the excess height freight cars to and from that location has ceased. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 41264, dated March 2, 1948, and the First Supplemental Order therein, Decision No. 48262, dated February 10, 1953, are hereby revoked.
