FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 50724, dated November 3, 1954, the Commission authorized Vallejo Electric Light and Power Company to transfer its properties to Pacific Gas and Electric Company and directed the latter to file, for approval, the journal entries it proposes to use to record the transaction on its books.

In its first supplemental application, filed on February 9, 1955, Pacific Gas and Electric Company has submitted its journal entries No. 11697, No. 11698 and No. 11698-A which it desires to use for the purpose of recording, as of December 31, 1954, the acquisition of the assets and the assumption of the liabilities of Vallejo Electric Light and Power Company. It has requested the Commission to approve said entries.

The Commission has considered the journal entries submitted by Pacific Gas and Electric Company and is of the opinion applicant's request should be granted, as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the journal entries filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company as Exhibit I to its first supplemental application in Application No. 34412 hereby are approved, provided, however, that such approval is not to be construed as a determination of the value of the properties represented by such journal entries for the purpose of fixing rates or for any other purpose:
