ORDER

The City of Fullerton is authorized to construct Laguna Road at grade across the Anahoim Branch of Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company, operated by Union Pacific Railroad Company, and the Fullerton Branch of Pacific Electric Railway Company, in the City of Fullerton, Orange County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 3Y-12.9 and 6CB-24.77, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The respective railroads shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex reflecting material.

Speeds of trains or cars across Crossing No. 6CB-24.77 shall be restricted to a maximum of 10 miles per hour.
