ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing that, by Decision No. 47107 dated May 5, 1952 in Application No. 33353, J. F. Homer was authorized to acquire a passenger stage operative right authorizing service between Sausalito and Marin City and intermediate points as created by Decision No. 38825 in Application No. 27003; that, during the month of October 1954, J. F. Homer, without appropriate authority, discontinued the passenger stage service theretofore conducted by him between Sausalito and Marin City pursuant to the foregoing described operative right; that, approximately since December 10, 1954, J. F. Homer has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for the payment of damages for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101; and that J. F. Homer has failed and refuses to reply to any written communications in connection with the foregoing.

Therefore, it is hereby found that J. F. Homer is no longer conducting and in fact has abandoned passenger stage operations between Sausalito and Marin City and intermediate points.

IT IS ORDERED that the passenger stage operative rights, created by Decision No. 38825 in Application No. 27003, and Decision No. 47107 in Application No. 33353, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of J. F. Homer are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon J. F. Homer.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after service thereof upon said J. F. Homer unless he shall have filed with the Commission a response to this order, in writing, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
