O R D E R

State of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to reconstruct the crossing of Watt Avenue at separated grades under the tracks of Southern Pacific Company, Crossing No. A-98.3-B, near Walerga Station, Sacramento County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto.

Construction and maintenance expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
