OPINION AND ORDER

By Application No. 36455, applicant sought authority to extend its pickup and delivery limits of El Centro as set forth in its Tariff No. 49-C, Cal.P.U.C. No. 53. This authority was granted by Decision No. 50882 of December 21, 1954. Applicant now seeks like authority in connection with its Tariff No. 79, Cal.P.U.C. No. 69 so as to maintain uniformity between its tariffs.

Competing carriers have been notified of the filing of the application. Granting of the application is not opposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the granting of the sought authority is justified.


Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Motor Trucking Company be and it is hereby authorized to enlarge its pickup and delivery zone at El Centro as requested and to establish for the transportation involved, not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, rates no lower than those prescribed for like transportation to and from El Centro.


IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire unless exercised within sixty days after the effective date of this order.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.


