SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By decisions in the above-entitled matter the Commission heretofore has authorized Colfax Telephone Exchange to issue \$228,000 of notes to the United States of America, acting through the Rural Electrification Administration, for the purpose of financing the cost of improvements and extensions to its plants and properties. The authorization of the Commission required applicant to file for approval a copy of each requisition for an advance of funds under the loan contract. Heretofore, the Commission has approved requisitions for \$102,368.09.

Applicant now seeks approval of additional expenditures of \$1,139.50 for the completion of its building and \$32,701.84 for


the payment of labor and material costs for station and drop installations, the two items aggregating \$33,841.34.

The Commission has considered this request and is of the opinion it should be granted, therefore,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the requisition of Colfax Telephone Exchange to draw down \$33,841.34 of proceeds from the issue of notes heretofore authorized by the Commission hereby is approved and Colfax Telephone Exchange is authorized to disburse said sum of \$33,841.34 for the purposes indicated in said requisition.


This sixth supplemental order will become effective on the date hereof.


