O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across County Road 32 near Davis, Yolo County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. A-76.5-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach as shown in the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B) equipped with reflex - reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry involved has an urgent need for this track in order to receive rail shipments of heavy structural trusses to be used in building construction now in progress and requests that the authorization sought be made effective immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
