O R D E R

County of Tehama is authorized to reconstruct F.A.S. Route No. 1080 at grade across the Shasta Route (Siskiyou) Main Line of Southern Pacific Company near Proberta, Tehama County, at the location described in the application, identified as Crossing No. C-215.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 26 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 3 crossing signals (G.O. No. 75-B). Reflectorized "Stop When Swinging" signs shall be installed on said crossing signals.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity,

or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be  
twenty days after the date hereof.
