SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicants heretofore requested the Commission to issue its order authorizing the exclusion from their certificated highway common carrier operating rights ⁽¹⁾ of service to and from Pittsburg.

By Decision No. 50886, dated December 21, 1954, the Commission authorized applicants to suspend their highway carrier service to and from Pittsburg for a period of 100 days from such date during which time the Commission's staff was to make a study of the matters involved. Such study has been made and the Commission is now of the opinion that the relief sought should be granted. The ensuing order will so provide.

O R D E R

An application having been filed, the Commission being of the opinion that the authority requested should be granted,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That ordering paragraph (1)(d) of Decision No. 47423 dated June 30, 1952, in Application No. 32048, is amended to read:

(1) By Decision No. 47423, dated June 30, 1952, M. S. Dodd was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing highway common carrier service between, among other points in Central California, Oakland and Pittsburg, subject to the condition that iron and steel articles, including tin plate, in shipments of 20,000 pounds or more, are not to be transported to or from Pittsburg.

Between Oakland and Pittsburg, but not including Pittsburg, and intermediate points as follows: U. S. Highway 40 from Oakland to Selby, unnumbered highway from Selby to junction State Highway 4 near Pittsburg, State Highway 4 from said junction to Pittsburg. Benicia to be served as an off-route point.

Alternate route - State Highway 4 from Hercules to Pittsburg.

(2) That ordering paragraph (2)(a) of Decision No. 47423 is deleted in its entirety.

(3) That in all other respects Decision No. 47423 shall remain in full force and effect.

(4) That applicants shall upon not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public, supplement their tariffs reflecting the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
