ORDER SETTING ASIDE SUBMISSION
AND REOPENING FOR FURTHER HEARING

Applicant seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to conduct operations as a "water corporation" within specified areas of Orange County. A public hearing was held at Santa Ana on January 20, 1955, at which time the matter was submitted.

In a petition filed March 15, 1955, applicant alleges that during the course of said hearing the Commission's staff indicated that the proposed system required further analysis to avoid any prospect of overconstruction; that since such hearing the system has been redesigned. The petition contains an amendment which sets forth cost, revenue and expense figures relating to the redesigned system. Applicant requests that Application No. 36204 be reopened so that such amendment may be considered by the Commission.

Now therefore, IT IS ORDERED that submission of the above entitled matter is set aside and the proceeding reopened for further

h hearing before the Commissioner or Examiner and at such time and place as hereafter may be designated by notice of the Secretary.
