 to construct a grade crossing of the) Application No. 36698
 Southern Pacific Railroad at Zinfandel.)

O R D E R

County of Sacramento is authorized to construct Zinfandel Drive at grade across a branch line track of Southern Pacific Company near Mills, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AH-102.9. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than four percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. 75-B) equipped with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion, a private railroad grade crossing located about 400 feet easterly shall be closed by Southern Pacific Company by erecting effective barriers so as to prevent its use by vehicular traffic. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the real estate development of the property southerly of said crossing is being retarded pending granting

of this application and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
