O R D E R

The verified application of Tidewater Southern Railway Company filed on March 10, 1955, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Rogers during the past five years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Tidewater Southern Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Rogers, County of Stanislaus; to remove a spur track of approximately 492 feet in length, a fruit packing shed and a loading platform at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
