FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 51315, issued April 12, 1955, among other things, authorized applicant to file the increased rates set forth in Exhibit B to the application in connection with the establishment of a new Patton Village exchange. Said Exhibit B set forth a monthly rate of \$6.50 for each 10-party suburban business flat rate station. The application alleged an intent to apply existing Susanville exchange rates in the new exchange. The present Susanville rate for the named service is \$7.00 per station. The decision, in setting forth the \$6.50 rate, stated that such rate was the same as that currently effective in the Susanville exchange. To correct this inadvertent error,

IT IS ORDERED that applicant may file a rate of \$7.00 per month for each 10-party suburban business flat rate station in its Patton Village exchange.

In all other respects, Decision No. 51315 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
