SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company on May 25, 1955 filed with the Commission a request for an extension of time of forty-five (45) days from the time limit mentioned in Condition No. 4 of Decision No. 51251, dated March 29, 1955.

Applicant alleges that due to material shortages it has been unable to install adequate telltales on each side of all of the overhead structures having a clearance of less than 23 feet, 8 inches above top of rail as required by said condition in the operation of 16 feet, 8 inch excess height freight cars.

It appears that this request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit within which Southern Pacific Company shall comply with Condition No. 4 in Decision No. 51251 is hereby extended to and including July 15, 1955.

In all other respects Decision No. 51251 shall remain in force and effect.
