# SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 provides rates, rules and regulations for the transportation of rock, sand and other materials in dump trucks between designated production areas and delivery zones in Orange and San Bernardino counties. Mileage and hourly rates are provided for movements between points not covered by the zoning arrangements. The mileage and hourly rates are generally higher than the zone rates. By Petitions for Modification Nos. 13 and 14 in this proceeding, California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., seeks extension of the zone rate system to cover deliveries from two recently established production facilities located outside the present production area.

petitioner represents that the average monthly production at each of the facilities will be several thousand tons of rock and sand, and that a substantial amount of this material will be transported by for-hire dump trucks to nearby points. It states that the mileage and hourly rates are not suitable for such movements, and that the establishment of zone rates as proposed would be of benefit to carriers, shippers and the general public.

Interested parties have been notified of the filing of the petitions. No objection to their being granted has been received.

C.5437(Pets. 13 & 14)

The proposed extension of the zone rate system is justified. The petitions will be granted.

A public hearing is not deemed necessary.
