FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Lamb Transportation Company, a corporation, holds a highway contract carrier permit. By Decision No. 50031 of May 11, 1954, in this proceeding, Lora Lamb, C. Jerry Lamb, Jr., Colin J. Boone and Albert F. Cruse, a predecessor partnership, were authorized to observe a rate less than the minimum rate otherwise applicable to the transportation of ground talc in bulk for the American Mineral Company from Los Angeles to Kaiser. The authority is scheduled to expire May 31, 1955. By this supplemental application the corporation asks for similar authority to deviate from the minimum rate.

The supplemental application states that the conditions surrounding the transportation in question which justified deviation from the minimum rate still obtain and that continued relief is necessary in order that applicant may retain the traffic. However, applicant's allegations are not fully persuasive that the sought extension of the authority should be granted without further investigation. Meanwhile, continuation of the present basis for a ninety-day period will be authorized. To prevent a lapse of applicant's authority, the order will be made effective immediately.

Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 50031 of May 11, 1954, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby amended by substituting




This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
