ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on April 19, 1955, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Shasta Springs for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its Class "C" non-agency station of Shasta Springs, County of Siskiyou; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
