SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 51498, dated May 24, 1955, in Application No. 36705 Pacific Gas and Electric Company was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the electrical franchise granted by the City Council of the City of Larkspur by Ordinance No. 223. Inadvertently the order refers to the date of August 18, 1955, as being the date upon which Ordinance No. 223 was adopted rather than August 18, 1954. Therefore good cause appearing,
