Application of TEDDY'S TAXI CORPORATION, a California corporation, to abandon and revoke operative rights.) Application No. 37015

O P I N I O N

By the above-entitled application Teddy's Taxi Corporation seeks the Commission's authority to discontinue the passenger stage service it presently conducts between Sacramento and the Sacramento Municipal Airport. The certificate of public convenience and necessity covering that operation was acquired by applicant by Decision No. 41711, dated June 15, 1948, in Application No. 29264.

As justification therefor applicant refers to the allegations set forth in Application No. 37001 wherein Capitol Transportation Co. requests a certificate to institute a similar service between Sacramento and the airport to supersede that now provided by Teddy's Taxi Corporation. That matter is being considered by the Commission concurrently with this application. In general, it is asserted that applicant herein is in imminent danger of having all its physical assets seized by the Director of Internal Revenue for nonpayment of taxes in the approximate sum of \$30,000. When that occurs applicant will be unable to continue the service now conducted.

O R D E R

An application therefor having been filed and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That applicant Teddy's Taxi Corporation is hereby authorized to discontinue passenger stage operations between

Sacramento and Sacramento Municipal Airport, concurrently with the establishment of similar service by Capitol Transportation Co. as authorized by the Commission in Decision No. 51570 in Application No. 37001.

(2) That upon the discontinuance of such service by applicant and the commencement of similar service by Capitol Transportation Co., the operative right created by Decision No. 41711 shall be deemed revoked. Likewise all effective tariffs and timetables of applicant shall thereupon be deemed cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
