O P I N I O N

Hughes & Hartman, copartners, are highway carriers engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued them by this Commission.

Applicants seek an order authorizing them to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of lumber and forest products between numerous points north of San Bernardino and Newport Beach and south of Crescent City and Happy Camp.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

The application does not contain evidence sufficient to constitute a showing that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of the proposed service. The application will therefore be denied.
