O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, filed on May 7, 1955, discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Gallinas during the past three years and its continued maintenance is not necessary as a station at which carload freight is handled.

Good cause appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Gallinas, County of Marin, from Class "B" to Class "D" or a station at which freight in lots not exceeding 5,000 pounds (no piece to be larger than two men can handle) will be handled; to remove a spur track of approximately 650 feet in length located at said station; to change its station records accordingly; and to effect the necessary changes in all applicable tariffs on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after reclassification and abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised

within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
