SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Prior decisions in this proceeding have authorized William E. Hibbitt and David Macaulay, partners doing business as Lawrence Warehouse & Distributing Co., to suspend the operation of 27,550 square feet of warehouse space in Sacramento. The authority expires July 13, 1955. A one-year extension of this authority is sought.

Applicants assert that they are in the process of negotiating for suitable replacement space but will be unable to complete the negotiations prior to the expiration date of the present suspension authority.

In the circumstances it appears that applicants should be granted an extension of the authority. However, the sought one-year extension does not appear to be justified. Instead, the suspension authority will be extended for a six-month period and the order will be made effective July 13, 1955, to prevent a lapse of applicants' authority. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted William E. Hibbitt and David Macaulay, partners doing business as Lawrence Warehouse & Distributing Co., by Decision

No. 48746 of June 23, 1953, as amended, in this proceeding, be and it is hereby extended to January 13, 1956, unless sooner changed or further extended by order of the Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects Second Supplemental Application No. 34382 be and it is hereby denied.

This order shall become effective July 13, 1955.
