THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 48405 herein dated March 24, 1953, authority was granted to Haslett Warehouse Company to suspend operations of 126,680 square feet of warehouse floor space for one year because leases held by it upon certain warehouse properties in San Francisco had expired. This authority was extended for an additional year by Decision No. 49825 dated March 23, 1954.

By supplemental application filed March 17, 1955, applicant requested a further one year extension of the authority because it has not been able to lease suitable space in order to resume operations. In Decision No. 51306 dated April 12, 1955, the Commission found that the applicant's allegations were not fully persuasive that public convenience and necessity would be served by suspension of operations for a further one-year period. The Commission extended the authority for 90 days in order to afford applicant and interested parties opportunity to present evidence at a public hearing from which it might be determined whether a longer suspension should be granted.

The authority to suspend warehouse operations will expire July 12, 1955. Applicant has been afforded opportunity to present evidence at a public hearing. It has chosen not to avail itself

of this opportunity and has indicated to the Commission's staff that it does not desire to go forward in this matter.

Applicant having failed to avail itself of opportunity to prosecute its application, and, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that First Supplemental Application filed in this proceeding be and it is hereby dismissed.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
