Walter A. Lambert and Emma Lambert are highway carriers engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued them by this Commission.

Applicants seek an order authorizing them to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of iron, steel and scrap iron between San Francisco, South San Francisco, Oakland, Niles and Torrance and Southern San Joaquin Valley points.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

The application does not contain evidence sufficient to constitute a showing that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of the proposed service. The application will therefore be denied.
