O P I N I O N

Louis A. Morrison, Jr. is a highway carrier engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to a permit issued him by this Commission.

He seeks an order authorizing him to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of lumber from the California-Oregon border to San Francisco, Oakland, San Jose, Stockton, Bakersfield, Fresno, Madera, Merced, Los Angeles, Redding, Red Bluff, Anderson, Burney, Alturas, Susanville, Westwood, Yuba City, Marysville, Grass Valley, Sacramento, Roseville, Woodland and Oroville.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

The application does not contain evidence sufficient to constitute a showing that public convenience and necessity require the establishment of the proposed service. The application will therefore be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 36270 is denied.
