O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a drill track and interchange track at grade across Beard Street in the City of Modesto, Stanislaus County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. B-113.45-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by one existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G. O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industries involved contemplate construction as soon as possible and ask that the authorization requested be made effective immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
