O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Santa Fe Avenue and Victoria Street in the County of Los Angeles at the locations described in the application to be identified as Crossings Nos. BG-495.6-C and BG-496.1-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection for each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) with two flood lights at Crossing No. BG-495.6-C so placed as to illuminate each side of rail cars during the hours of darkness.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

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with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
