O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across an unnamed alley in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

It is alleged that said unnamed alley is not at present open to public use and travel, and this order is not to be deemed authority for such opening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

It is alleged that the industry involved now withholds the shipment of carload freight pending construction of this spur track and it is asked that the authorization requested be made effective

immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
