FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 51468, dated May 16, 1955, in Application No. 36837, N. T. Chastain, doing business as Redding City Lines, was authorized to establish increased passenger fares. On May 20, 1955, applicant filed a supplemental application requesting that Exhibit "D" be amended to correct certain errors and omissions. The amendment does not affect the level of fares. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph (1) of Decision No. 51468, dated May 16, 1955, in Application No. 36837, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) That N. T. Chastain, doing business as Redding City Lines, is hereby authorized to establish, on not less than three days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the fares proposed in Application No. 36837 and in First Supplemental Application No. 36837."
