ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE AUTHORITY

It appearing by Decision No. 28935, dated June 29, 1936, in Application No. 20563, a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing highway common carrier service was issued to K. G. Harris, doing business as Harris Drayage Company; that pursuant to Decision No. 35430, dated June 2, 1942, in Application No. 24816, said operative rights were acquired by William F. Tandy and Carlton S. Tandy, doing business as Tandy Bros., and that by letter dated June 16, 1955 said partnership states that all its for-hire trucks have been sold and it is no longer engaged in the trucking business.

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY FOUND that William F. Tandy and Carlton S. Tandy are no longer conducting and in fact have abandoned their highway common carrier operations as authorized by said Decision No. 28935.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by said Decision No. 28935 and acquired by William F. Tandy and Carlton S. Tandy pursuant to said Decision No. 35430 is hereby revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all effective rates, rules and regulations on file with the Commission governing and applying to the operations of said William F. Tandy and Carlton S. Tandy are hereby cancelled and revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon William F. Tandy and Carlton S. Tandy.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after service thereof upon said William F. Tandy and Carlton S. Tandy, unless they shall have filed with the Commission a response to this order in writing, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until a public hearing is held and a further order is issued.
