O P I N I O N

Bay Rapid Transit Company, presently rendering a passenger stage service between Carmel, Monterey, Pacific Grove and Fort Ord requests authority to discontinue direct service to the U. S. Naval School in Monterey and to amend its Routes 6 and 9.

It is asserted that service to the school would be adequately provided by Route 6. Routes 6 and 9 as proposed are designed to better serve the constantly growing areas of Ord Village and Seaside.

As justification for the authority sought, applicant alleges that it has been operating at a loss for several years; that the elimination of direct service to the school will tend to decrease operating costs and that in addition to greater operating economies the revision of Routes 6 and 9 will be of considerable advantage to residents and patrons desiring the changes and modifications as proposed.

The commanding officer of the U. S. Naval School informed the Commission by letter that there would be no objection to the reroutings as proposed.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises;

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 46911 dated March 25, 1952, in Application No. 33045 is hereby amended by deleting the additional route in Monterey to the U. S. Naval School and redescribing Routes 6 and 9 to read as follows:

Route 6

Monterey-Seaside-Fort Ord Village

Beginning at the intersection of Del Monte Avenue and Tyler Street, thence along Del Monte Avenue; Broadway, Noche Buena Avenue, Pine Avenue, Waring Way, Waring Avenue, Military Avenue, Noche Buena Avenue, Ord Grove Avenue, Fremont Street, Broadway, Del Monte Avenue to point of commencement.

Route 9

Monterey-Seaside-Del Monte Heights

Beginning at the intersection of Del Monte Avenue and Tyler Street in Monterey, thence along Tyler Street, Munras Avenue, Fremont Street, Hilby Avenue, Noche Buena Avenue, Broadway, Fremont Street, Munras Avenue, Tyler Street to point of commencement.

Beginning at the intersection of Fremont Street and Airport Road, along Airport Road to U. S. Naval Auxiliary Air Base and return to Fremont Street via same route.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant be and it is hereby authorized to amend its tariffs and timetables, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, to reflect the changes authorized in the above ordering paragraph.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
