## <u>ORDER</u>

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across the intersection of Watson and Bronson Streets in the City of Santa Cruz, Santa Cruz County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. EC-119.3. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streetsnow graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

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Applicant alleges that the industry involved contemplates immediate construction and asks that the authorization requested be made effective immediately.

Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
