O R D E R

The State of California, Department of Public Works is authorized to construct Peach Avenue at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near Livingston, Merced County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. B-138.4. Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Applicant shall bear maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-six feet and grades of approach not greater than six percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-138.2 about 1,000 feet westerly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not

exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
