## Decision No. 51771

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of KIT CARSON STAGES (formerly Bibb Stage Line), a corporation, for an extension of its existing passenger stage certificate to include operations along State Highway 88 from Jackson to points east of Bartons to and including Silver Lake, points and places around Silver Lake, Stockton Municipal Camp and all intermediate points.

## OPINION AND ORDER

Kit Carson Stages, presently rendering a passenger stage service between Bartons and Silver Lake and intermediate points, requests authority to render said service on a yearly "on-call" basis.

Said authority was granted by Decision No. 44332, dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31432, which provided that a scheduled service be provided daily from approximately June 15 to September 15 and an "on-call" service provided the remainder of the year.

The Commission has been informed that service was primarily furnished to construction workers. The job was completed in 1953 and no passengers have been transported since that time. It is anticipated that a construction project will commence in the near future. Until such time applicant desires that service be "on-call".

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion that it would be more advisable to suspend the above-described operative rights for the period of a year, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by the Commission. If no need for service exists at the end of that time said operative rights will be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the operative rights granted by Decision No. 44332, dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31432, are hereby suspended until August 1, 1956, unless sooner canceled, changed or extended by the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty days after the date hereof applicant shall file a supplement to his tariff and timetables indicating suspension thereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
