ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct three new pedestrian crossings at separated grades under State Route 199 and the Coronado Branch Line of the San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company, referred to herein as the "Silver Strand State Park Pedestrian Undercrossings", to be identified as Crossings Nos. 36C-10.44-BD, 36C-10.61-BD, and 36C-10.77-BD, respectively, and also to remove existing spur track grade crossing across the Route 199 highway, being Crossing No. 36C-7.3-C, County of San Diego, in the manner described in Exhibit "A", as amended, all at locations shown upon the map, Exhibits "B" and "C", attached to the application.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with agreements entered into between applicant and San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans of said pedestrian crossings approved by the railroad, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Within thirty days after completion of the undercrossings and the removal of the spur track crossing pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
