O P I N I O N

Applicant Dewey Poulscen has been operating under authority of a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by this Commission in Decision No. 46243 dated October 2, 1951 in Application No. 32406. By the present application filed June 24, 1955, he seeks to transfer this operation to a partnership composed of himself and his son. No consideration of any cash value is to be made for the transfer. All the operative property is to be owned by the two applicants as partners.

The Commission finds that the proposed transfer will not be adverse to the public interest. The application also requests the issuance of a new certificate identical with that to be transferred. This request appears to be unnecessary and will be denied. A public hearing is unnecessary. The action taken herein shall not be construed as a finding of the value of the rights herein authorized to be transferred.

O R D E R

The Commission having considered the above-entitled matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is unnecessary and that the proposed transfer of operative rights is not adverse to the public interest,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That within sixty days after the effective date hereof the operative rights and properties of Dewey Poulsen above referred to may be transferred to said Dewey Poulsen and Loren D. Poulsen as copartners and that they may hereafter exercise the rights granted by said Decision No. 46243.

(2) That within thirty days after completion of the transfer herein authorized, applicants shall notify the Commission in writing and within said period shall file with it true copies of any instruments of transfer executed to effect such transfer.

(3) That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicants shall join in supplementing or reissuing the tariffs now on file with the Commission naming rates, rules, and regulations governing the operations here involved to show that, as partners, Dewey Poulsen and Loren D. Poulsen have adopted or established as their own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply in all respects with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

(4) That in all other respects Application No: 37067  
is denied.
