<u>O P I N I O N</u>

Pacific Produce Company of Bakersfield, a corporation, is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to a permit issued by this Commission.

It seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of "general agricultural commodities, produce and meat" from points in Kern County to Los Angeles, San Francisco, San Diego and Sacramento and "groceries, agricultural commodities and produce" from Los Angeles to Bakersfield, Fresno, Stockton and Sacramento.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common carriers subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application and the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice, it appears that as of the date of the filing of the application applicant, in transporting agricultural commodities and meat from points in Kern County to Los Angeles, San Francisco, San Diego and Sacramento, was conducting its operations within the scope of the permitted authority heretofore issued by this Commission. Such operations not having constituted highway common carriage, the sought certificate of public convenience and necessity is not a requisite for their continuance. It further appears that
