O R D E R

The City of Oxnard, Ventura County, is authorized to construct two crossings at grade across the track of the Ventura County Railway Company at engineer's stations 258+21 and 265+56, substantially in the manner described in above application and as shown on maps Exhibits "A", "B", "C", and "E" attached thereto, to be identified as Crossings Nos. 45-0.74 and 45-0.88, respectively. The entire construction expense shall be borne by applicant. Maintenance costs of the above two crossings outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Maintenance costs between such lines shall be borne by Ventura County Railway Company. Width of each crossing shall be not less than 25 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction of each crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection at each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

It is alleged that the drive-in theater is nearing completion and that the two crossings are needed for the public's use. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
