ORDER

The City of Los Angeles is authorized to widen Beverly Glen Boulevard (Crossing No. 6S-11.66-B) under the Santa Monica Boulevard Line of Pacific Electric Railway Company and to construct and improve said separated crossing in the manner described in the above application and as shown upon the map, Exhibit "A", attached thereto.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing the proposed widening.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within

one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
