O P I N I O N

Pacific Motor Trucking Company requests authority to transport bulk cement in special hopper body equipment in lots of not less than 40,000 pounds from Jamestown to the construction sites of Beardsley Dam and Donnell Dam, which are located on the Middle Fork of the Stanislaus River.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that construction plans call for the use of cement on or about September 1, 1955; that it will take approximately four years to complete construction of the dams; that during said period it is estimated that Donnell Dam will require about 67,400 tons of cement and Beardsley Dam will require about 7,125 tons of cement, and that no other carrier is presently authorized to provide the proposed service.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary. Because the movement of cement is scheduled to commence the first of September the order will be made effective on the date hereof.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission having been informed in the premises.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Motor Trucking Company, authorizing it to operate as a highway common carrier for the transportation of bulk cement from Jamestown to Beardsley Dam and Donnell Dam via California Highways 49 and 108 and via any and all unnumbered roads between said points.

(2) That in providing the service herein authorized applicant shall observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and upon not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and shall file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
